- *help with lunchtime supervision during full-time camp sessions
- *work closely with Counselors-in-Training to help make each day of camp a success for each camper.

The ideal candidate will have:

- * a positive attitude!
- * experience teaching groups of youth in either a school or summer camp environment
- * an interest in learning more about teaching from an experienced teacher and camp director
- * an interest in child development
- * patience, flexibility, a sense of humor
- * excellent written and verbal communication skills
- * maturity and a willingness to learn (minimum age is 16).
- * willingness to take direction
- * a strong sense of responsibility and reliability
